Examples of bodies we may need to share your data with include but are not limited to: caterers who need to be aware of special dietary requirements, breed societies to verify entries, external contractors such as marquee and electricity suppliers and for safety purposes your emergency contact details may be shared with relevant bodies. During The Royal Cheshire County Show you may be photographed and images may be used at a later date for promotional purposes.

The Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO recognises that you have rights surrounding the data we hold. Individuals may contact the Society's Data Protection Officer (DPO) and exercise your rights to be informed about the data we hold, have access to the data we hold, have your data rectified, your right to be forgotten and so forth. Should you make a data request the Society will endeavour to respond within the statutory period.

The Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO will endeavour to keep your data safe and will notify you and the Information Commissioners Officer (ICO) should it become aware of any data breach, within the legal time limit of 72 hours. CLOSING DATE – 21 April

1. HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW ENTRIES - As a requirement of our affiliation to Horse of the Year Show, entries to these classes **MUST** be made on a separate entry form and a Royal Cheshire County Show entry form or via our online facility. Forms must be completed fully, or they will be returned to you.
2. Online - Entries and payments can now be processed online. Please visit the website at www.royalcheshireshow.org
3. Mandatory Payment towards Medical Cover In line with other shows each exhibitor must pay a £3 contribution towards medical cover.
4. One Entry Form to be completed per OWNER please. Additional forms are available on our website at www.royalcheshireshow.org or by telephoning 01565 650200, alternatively they can be photocopied if necessary.
5. Please provide as much information as possible. Write clearly in block capitals. If society registration numbers are requested to comply with class requirements, then they **MUST** be listed.
6. Before returning your entries ensure you retain a copy for your records.
7. Entry Fees will be accepted by cheque and credit card in £ Sterling only. Post-dated cheques will be returned. Please do not send cash through the post. **ENTRIES WILL BE VOID AND RETURNED IF ANY CHEQUES ARE DISHONoured.**

- f) Any exhibitor in charge of an entire must ensure they are in complete control at all times and if not, will be dismissed from the ring.
- g) All entries in Sport Horse classes must be on the Society's Basic Identity Record or Stud Book.
- h) The Society discourages the showing of over-fat horses and judges will take this into consideration when making their awards.
- i) Manners will be taken into account in In Hand Sport Horse Classes.

The Price Family Supreme In hand Championship Please note that geldings 4 yrs of age and over are not eligible for The Price Family Supreme In hand Championship. If this applies to the Champion, then qualification will pass to the Reserve Champion.

This is a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier, all data given upon entry of these classes is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. Classes 4, 5, 6, 8 are qualifiers for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 4th-8th October 2023. In the Lightweight Show Hunter, Middleweight Show Hunter, Heavyweight Show Hunter and Small Show Hunter Classes, the highest placed **unqualified** horse in the **first five** will qualify to enter at the Horse of the Year Show. No horse lower than **5th** will qualify with the exception of the BSHA National Championship Show. Entries in the three weight classes are not eligible to enter the Small Hunter Class and vice versa. Competitors must enter their horses in the appropriate classes and the judge will have the power to transfer exhibits to the appropriate weight class. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office. Only horses registered with the BSHA are eligible to enter. These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk. This class entitles eligible amateur combinations to earn points for the Premier Amateur League, with the opportunity of gaining a wild card place at HOYS 2023. This is open to current TSR members or those that have signed up to the Premier Amateur League 2023, for more information see www.theshowingregister.co.uk.

The highest placed unqualified exhibit in classes 4-6 & 8 will qualify to compete in the BSHA Supreme of Season Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA Hunter & National Championship Shows in September 2023.

WORKING HUNTER OF THE YEAR In the Working Hunter of the Year Class, the highest placed **unqualified** horse in the first three will qualify to enter at Horse of the Year Show. No horse lower than 3rd will qualify. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.

Horses competing at the Horse of the Year Show and qualifying shows in The Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB(GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

SHB(GB) Class Rules All other Hunter Classes, EXCLUDING HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW QUALIFIERS, will be judged under Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain 2023 Rules. The following regulations relate to SHB(GB) classes. SHB(GB) REQUIRE ALL EXHIBITS IN RIDDEN HUNTER CLASSES TO BE REGISTERED (except Local Class). Day Ticket = £36 This entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year at £36 per show - it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show - tel 01732 866277 for details.

THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS APPLY:-

- 1 ANYONE on a horse at an affiliated show must wear a hard hat.
- 2 It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear correctly secured skull caps/riding hats that meet one of the following current safety standards:-
All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards: SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. It is mandatory for competitors under the age of 18 to wear such skull caps or hats.
- 3 The Organisers of this Show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, all Officials and Stewards.

Points will be awarded to 1st - 4th places in each class. Horses must be registered or over stamped with SHB(GB) to qualify. Horses can compete in any of the above classes. An award will be made to the horse attaining the highest number of points overall.

This Section is a qualifier for **The National Welsh Championship Show 2023 - National Ridden Welsh Part Bred Championships**. All 1st & 2nd placed WPCS registered Welsh Part Bred exhibits in each class (not already qualified) qualify to enter. Unregistered qualifiers with 12.5% Welsh blood may retrospectively register with WPCS prior to entry.

A Mare, Gelding or Stallion 4 years old or over (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail).

For Horses exceeding 148cms (14.2hh approx) to be judged in accordance with the rules herein set out. Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A Show Jumper or Advanced Event horse as at 1 January in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter Classes. Marks must be awarded in the following way: The maximum total points available is 100. PHASE I (60 marks), A: Jumping points = Max 40 points, B: Style & Presence while Jumping = Max 20 points, PHASE II (40 marks) C: Ride = Max 20 points, D: Conformation = Max 20 points. In the event of equality, the conformation mark from phase II will take precedence, followed by the ride mark and then the style mark. Fences to be minimum of 8 in number and a maximum of 12 and will contain a combination and should contain a water tray. Maximum height of 1.14m (3ft 9ins) at the discretion of the Judges. Fences should have a natural appearance and not be easily dislodged. No un-numbered obstacle can be included in the course. The course must contain a combination and should contain a water tray. This class will be judged in two parts. Part One (Jumping) will be judged first, without a jump-off. All clear rounds and any other horses the judges may require will go forward to the next part. A rider can ride up to two horses in the jumping phase but then must select only one horse to take forward into the ride and conformation section if so required.

The manner of going to be taken into account. No change of rider or tack will be allowed (unless a horse is ridden under side saddle, in which case, in order to allow the judge to ride, the saddle may be changed for the riding phase only). A rider can ride up to two horses in the jumping phase but then must select only one horse to take forward into the ride and conformation section if so required (no change of rider allowed). A skull cap or hat and safety harness according to the current approved BSI or European Standard must be worn by ALL competitors in the jumping phase of Working Hunter classes. Skull caps must have a navy blue or black cover. No hind boots or bandages of any description are allowed in the collecting ring, warm up or in the actual class. On completion of the jumping phase ALL CLEAR ROUNDS and any other horses the judges may require, should be asked to return to the ring. If a horse positively stops, ceases to go forwards at any time during its jumping round, or turns its quarters to a fence, or has a complete turnaround, these constitute refusals. If a horse jumps an incorrect fence it will be eliminated. Horses displaying continued disobedience or horses leaving the ring whether mounted or dismounted will be eliminated.

- 2 **DISEASE** No animal will be accepted on the Showground with any sign of disease condition as confirmed by an appointed Veterinary Surgeon. Offending animals must be withdrawn from the Showground immediately.
- 3 **VETERINARY FEES** Exhibitors will be expected to meet any fees for veterinary attention which may be charged at the time.
- 4 **ENTRY FEES/REFUNDS** Under no circumstance will entry fees be returned in the case of cancellation of entries by an exhibitor or postponement or cancellation of the Show for whatever reason. Refunds will only be given on the production of a valid veterinary certificate together with the return of all exhibitor tickets and gate passes and a 20% administration fee will be applied.
- 5 **SUBSTITUTION** No substitution of entries will be permitted in any section after the closing date for entries. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES CAN AN ENTRY WHICH HAS BEEN INCORRECTLY ENTERED IN THE WRONG CLASS MOVE CLASSES.**
- 6 **ATTENDANTS** Exhibitors or their attendants must remain with their exhibits during the whole time they are at the Show and must comply with and be governed by the Society's Rules and Regulations.
- 7 **STALLIONS AND COLTS** 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and led by a handler that has attained their 18th birthday by 1 January of the current year.
- 8 **HEADWEAR** Anyone riding a horse or pony must wear a correctly secured hat to BSI or European Safety Standard specification and of a standard approved by the governing body of their respective horse or pony society. **Hats must be tagged in accordance with the relevant societies.**
- 9 **NUMBERING OF EXHIBITS** All exhibits must wear the number supplied by the Society for the appropriate class during the judging or in the Parade.
- 10 **JUDGING** will commence as near as circumstances allow, at the times stated in the Schedule under the respective sectional headings and exhibitors will be held responsible for their exhibits being in their respective ring at the proper time.
- 11 **JUDGES** named in the Society's Prize Schedule and Show Catalogue have been appointed and consented to act as Judges in the events indicated. The Committee reserves the right to appoint substitutes for any who may be unavoidably prevented from attending and all entries are accepted upon that understanding.
- 12 **PROTESTS** Any exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest must do so in writing to the Executive Director (within one hour of completion of judging) on the Show Day together with the sum of £25.00. All protests to be investigated by a committee consisting of at least three members of the Council whose decision shall be final.
- 13 **STEWARDS** The Committee delegates full power to the Stewards to enforce the Society's Rules and Regulations.
- 14 **POSTPONEMENT OR ABANDONMENT** Exhibitors shall not have any claim against the Society or any member of the Society in respect of any loss or damage whatsoever consequent upon the Show failing (for whatever reason) to be held.
- 15 **EXERCISING of horses must not be carried out on the Showground Roads, Walkways, Main Ring or Judging Rings. Only exhibitor and groom to be allowed in the collecting rings.**
- 16 **PRIZE VOUCHERS** will be issued with rosettes in the ring and prize money can be collected from the cash point by the main ring on Show days. Alternatively prize vouchers can be sent to the Show Office **before** 31 July. Prize Vouchers received after this date **will not be paid out. Prize money will not automatically be issued without a prize card voucher being sent to the Show Office.** Other additional payments will be issued by the Show Office within 8 weeks of the Show. Cheques not banked by end of September will be invalid and the Society will donate the value of the cheque to a charity of their choice.
- 17 **TROPHIES** remain the property of the Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO and will NOT be given out. There will be the opportunity for the winning exhibitor to be photographed with the trophy at the Trophy Marquee.
- 18 **DOGS** No dogs will be allowed in the rings to accompany any entries in any classes. No dogs will be allowed in horse walks or collecting rings.
- 19 **DOPING** The Society takes a very serious view of doping, whether intentional or unintentional. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor, particularly in the twenty four hours before the Show, to ensure that nothing is fed, administered or applied to an animal that contains a prohibited substance. Ignorance is not an adequate defence.
- 20 **CURRENT ANIMAL WELFARE LEGISLATION** applies at this Show and the Society will support by action where any breach of such legislation occurs.
- 21 **ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT** of any description brought to the Show must have a current PAT test certificate.
- 22 **PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE** Exhibitors must carry adequate public liability cover.
- 23 **ENTRIES CLOSE WITH FEES – 21 APRIL 2023 - NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.**
